

Taradale RSA Monthly Members Prize Terms and Conditions

1. The Taradale RSA Monthly Members Prize (the "Competition") is run by The Taradale RSA. Information on how to enter and the prize(s) form part of these terms and conditions. By participating, entrants agree to be bound by these terms and conditions.
2. ELIGIBILITY: Employees may not enter the competition. Entrants must be 18 years or over, and be a member of the Taradale RSA.
3. COMPETITION ENTRY: Entry method is by each accumulation of purchase or purchases totalling forty (\$40) New Zealand Dollars (NZD), will be equal to one entry. All entries can only be made by swiping a members card when making purchases, any amounts purchased without swiping a members card will not be included in any accumulation and as a result will not be able to be included for or towards an entry. Entrants may submit entries on a daily basis during the Competition period. Entries will be eligible to submit until the end of the Competition. The Taradale RSA reserves the right in its sole discretion to reject entries considered to be fraudulent in any way.
4. DATES: The Competition commences on Friday 06th December 2019 and closes on 7PM Saturday, 25th January 2019

All valid entries received in before Saturday at 7PM, 25th January will be eligible to win the prize draw. Any entries after this date will be invalid. 6. PRIZE WINNER: The winner must be present to receive their prize on the day of announcement. The winner will only be able to claim their prize upon presenting their Taradale RSA members card, and one form of Acceptable Identification. Failure to do so may result in a redraw and the announcement of a new winner until one is able to produce their member's card.
